
Post WorldZAF Patagonia • Option 2

The Brethren of the Coast explores the southern regions of Chile, including Torres del Paine and the Magellan Straits

Dates: October 26 to 31, 2026 (revised version 6 July 2026)



Joint Zafarrancho Naos Punta Arenas and Nao Natales

I. Important Notes

(a) We suggest to overnight at Santiago on the night of October 25th, hopefully near Santiago airport (SCL). There are several hotel options nearby, including (1) Hotel Holiday Inn, (2) Diego de Almagro, (3) Hilton, (4) La Quinta plus others.

(b) **The meeting point** will be at the LATAM counters, domestic terminal, upper/third floor at **6am on Monday 26 October 2026**.

(c) The suggested domestic flights should be purchased directly by the participants of the activity. If you need assistance and instead you want us to purchase those tickets on your behalf, please contact directly Brother **Albatros Errante** at claudio.vidal@mac.com.

Update (6 July 2026): For current or potential new participants to our Post Zaf Patagonia, who currently have difficulties to get the recommended flight tickets, then we suggest to fly on October 26th to Puerto Natales on the Sky airlines flight. Another option is to fly to Punta Arenas (PUQ) instead: on your arrival to Punta Arenas, we can arrange transportation to Puerto Natales on a scheduled public bus - duration of the drive is c. 3 hours.

(d) We have incorporated to the final price, the amount of USD 70 per person which corresponds to the commission that our Chilean bank charge us for each transaction. On the other hand, we strive to honor the final rate, however the dollar exchange rate trend may result in an involuntary but necessary rate adjustment.



II. Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 • Monday 26 October 2026

Meeting at Santiago airport for check-in at 6am

Flight from Santiago (SCL) to Puerto Natales (PNT) LA1 8:50am-1:17pm

There is another flight option today which is Flight SKY H2 2611 09:55am-2:43 (with stopover at Puerto Montt, without changing the plane).

Another possibility is to fly to Punta Arenas (PUQ) instead: on your arrival to Punta Arenas, we can arrange transportation to Puerto Natales on a scheduled public bus - duration of the drive is c. 3 hours.

Arrival to Puerto Natales and transfer to hotel in Puerto Natales

Free afternoon

Overnight Puerto Natales - Hotel Vendaval or similar (3-star category)

(No meals included)

Dress code: Casual.

Please remember that Patagonia is located at the southern tip of South America (51° to 53°S). Weather can be cold and windy, usually does not rain a lot. We suggest to bring a wind-proof and warm jacket and trousers, base layers is a good thing to carry also as well as gloves and a warm hat. In Puerto Natales there are many shops that sell (and rent) outdoor clothing suitable for the weather conditions. Bring good hiking shoes too. For the short hikes we are going to do (less than 1km) and if you consider necessary, bring a hiking poles for balance. Anyway, the hikes will be very short and easy, nothing strenuous.

Day 2 • Tuesday 27 October 2026

Boat trip to Balmaceda Glacier and Last Hope Fjord. Visit Bernardo O'Higgins National Park (7am-1pm). Note: This is a weather permitting activity.

Free afternoon

Overnight Puerto Natales - Hotel Vendaval or similar (3-star category)

(Breakfast, Lunch)

Dress code: Casual. Dress for outdoor activities and cold conditions. The boat have warm, indoor spaces but when going to outside decks, you can feel the cold and the wind. We will have a short hike (c. 1km one way) through the forests to a viewpoint with wonderful views of Serrano Glacier.

Day 3 • Wednesday 28 October 2026

Full day visit to Torres del Paine National Park (7am-3pm), visiting Laguna Amarga, the stunning Nordenskjöld, Sarmiento and Pehoé lakes as well as some of the most scenic and iconic locations in the park. Fantastic wildlife opportunities including Guanacos, Condors, Foxes and Flamingos.

Traditional Asado (Patagonian style barbecue) and Zafarrancho hosted by Captain Farucazo and crew of Nao Natales (3pm-7pm)

Transfer to Puerto Natales for overnight

Overnight Puerto Natales - Hotel Vendaval or similar (3-star category)

(Breakfast, Lunch in Serrano area)

Dress code: Casual. Dress for outdoor activities and cold conditions.

Day 4 • Thursday 29 October 2026

Morning transfer to Punta Arenas in regular bus (c. 3 hours)

Arrival to Punta Arenas and transfer to hotel

Afternoon visit to Maritime Museum Nao Victoria & Punta Arenas city tour

Evening Zafarrancho & Farewell dinner hosted by Captain “Blade Runner” and crew of Nao Punta Arenas (6.30-10pm)

Overnight Punta Arenas - Patagonia Hotel & Apart Suite or similar (3-star category)

(Breakfast, Lunch)

Dress code: Casual. Dress for windy conditions while doing the Punta Arenas city tour.

For the evening Zafarrancho use your full pirate attire.

Day 5 • Friday 30 October 2026

Boat trip to the Straits of Magellan (6am-3pm), exploring the south of the Brunswick Peninsula and admiring Tierra del Fuego and Dawson Island. This is a weather permitting activity.

Overnight Punta Arenas - Patagonia Hotel & Apart Suite or similar (3-star category)

(Breakfast, Packed Lunch, Dinner at Zafarrancho Nao Punta Arenas)

Dress code: Casual. Dress for outdoor activities and cold conditions. The boat have warm, indoor spaces but when going to outside decks, you can feel the cold and the wind.

Day 6 • Saturday 31 October 2026

Transfer to Punta Arenas airport
Flight Punta Arenas (PUQ) to Santiago de Chile (SCL) LA310 14:14-18:05
Connecting flights home
